10 things you can do to avoid becoming a victim of a SCAM

1. Never wire money to someone you have never met face-to-face.
2. Don't click on links or open attachments in unsolicited emails. Links can download malware onto your computer and be used to steal your identity, or can lead to fake "lookalike" websites.
3. Don't believe everything you see. Scammers are great at faking checks or business letters and will have lots of details to fool you. Just because it looks official doesn't mean that it is. Even Caller ID can be faked (via spoofing).
4. Don't buy online unless the transaction is secure. Make sure the website has "https" in the URL (the extra "s" is for "secure") and a small lock icon on the address bar. If you are unfamiliar with the company, research it first before buying or sending your money.
5. Be extremely cautious when you've met someone online and they want you to send them money. Scammers use dating websites, Craigslist, social media, and many other sites to reach potential targets. They can quickly feel like a friend or even a romantic partner, but that is part of the con to gain your trust.
6. Protect yourself from identity theft. Never share personally identifiable information with someone who's contacted you unsolicited — by phone, email, social media, or even at your front door. This includes banking and credit card information, your birthdate, and Social Security or insurance numbers.
7. Don't be pressured to act immediately. Scammers often promise a limited time offer and will push for a decision without letting you consult others. It's never a good idea to make an important decision quickly.
8. When possible, use secure, traceable transactions when making payments. Transactions made with a credit card can be disputed under federal law if they are fraudulent or defective. Wire transfers, cash, prepaid money cards and gift cards generally cannot be refunded.
9. Whenever possible, work with businesses that have proper identification, licensing, and insurance, especially contractors who will be coming into your home or anyone dealing with your money or sensitive information. Always research the company to see what other consumers have experienced.
10. Be cautious about what you or family members share on social media. Use privacy settings on all social media and online accounts. Imposters can use information found on social media to fool victims into thinking they are a friend or family.

DON'T BE A VICTIM! Ask questions. Say something if something doesn't seem right. Never be embarrassed to report problems to BBB® or other authorities.
