The Ritz Place Starlight Room

The Ritz Place Starlight Room is located at
104 E Madison Street on
the Marshfield square. This beautiful event
space is located upstairs



in what once was the old Ritz Theatre. The theater was built in 1919 and due to a fire in 1924 was rebuilt and reopened in 1927. The building seated 500 people and had an orchestra pit and stage for live music. The building played host to vaudeville entertainment, silent films, and then talkies, which lead to showing the modern movies we see today. The theater closed in 1973 and would be converted to retail space. For many years the building was home to Lurvey's Furniture and Carpet Shop. In 2008 the building was purchased by

Bo and Meredith Tonella from the daughter of Charles and Wilma

Brooks who had purchased the theater in 1934. After two years of extensive renovations, the building reopened in 2010 as "The Ritz Place". The building had been divided into two floors decades before.

After renovations the first floor is now multiple office and retail spaces. The upstairs with it's vast space, gleaming white tin ceiling and sparkling chandeliers is now The Ritz Place Starlight Room.

Decorated with a nod to the Art Deco era, this beautiful space is perfect for hosting up to 200 people for weddings, parties, showers, reunions and meetings. The Starlight Room is equipped with a caterer style kitchen, a dance floor, bride's room and bar area. There's even a marquee sign on the front of The Ritz Place building for a message of your choice. For 14 years The Starlight Room has been host to many beautiful weddings, family celebrations and HS reunions. In 2012 The Starlight room hosted a reception and book signing event for Jenna Bush Hager during The Cherry Blossom Festival. It was a highlight for the Tonella family to be part of such a wonderful community event.

Being a graduate of Marshfield HS, Meredith always wanted to continue to be a part of the wonderful community that helped raise her. She and her family hope that they can continue to host beautiful celebrations upstairs and successful businesses and retailers downstairs in The Ritz Place Building. Please check out and like
