**WC Partners** is the SB 40 Board for Webster County that determines how the tax levy funds paid by personal and real property are utilized within the county for individuals with developmental disabilities. The SB 40 board was incepted by the County Commissioners and is comprised of 9 board members that are parents, guardians and community members that have a vested interest in supporting individuals with developmental disabilities. The Mission of WC Partners is to advocate, to advance services, and positively impact the lives of Webster County citizens with developmental disabilities. In our daily work we strive to provide creative supports, strong advocacy, and quality services.

WC Partners also provides case management under a contract with the Department of Mental Health Developmental Disabilities Division. Support

Coordinators currently provide case management services to 247 individuals from the age of 3 to elderly, within Webster Co. Support Coordinators provide support, such as: information and guidance, advocacy, referrals to community resources, educational supports, assisting with navigating systems such as Social Security, and healthcare. Support Coordinators help determine eligibility, service needs, and identify appropriate services to address these needs.

WC Partners also offers classes or workshops for both individuals and families such as: music therapy, cooking, social gatherings, and guardianship workshop. Additional classes being offered soon. For more information please contact 417-630-0782 or email
