

When an emergency occurs we call 911, but who do we call when experiencing a mental health crisis? This is where a newer 3-digit number comes in, this number is 988. 988 was launched in the summer of 2022 by the State of Missouri. The three-digit number can be used as a text, call, chat, or videophone. The image below shows the

difference between 911 and 988.

SUICIDE PREVENTION - HOW YOU CAN HELP

You can make a difference. Help prevent suicide and get someone connected to the support they need. Know when and where to reach out for help.

WHEN EVERY SECOND COUNTS...CONTACT 911

Life or death emergencies require immediate action from emergency responders because every second counts.

CONTACT 911 IF THEY:

- Are in imminent danger or believe someone else is in danger
- Have a self-injury that needs immediate medical attention
- Are overdosing
- Are unresponsive
- Tell you they have made a suicide attempt that requires immediate attention

WHEN THERE IS TIME TO TALK...CONTACT 988

A mental health, suicide, or substance use crisis may not require emergency response, but does require compassionate assistance.

CONTACT 988 IF THEY:

- Want to end their life or hurt themselves
- Have a self-injury, but it does not require immediate medical attention
- Are at risk for suicide and using alcohol or drugs
- Are at risk for suicide and are emotionally upset, depressed, or angry
- Feel like they cannot guarantee their own safety
