



Marshfield, MO – The Webster County Health Unit has a question for everyone looking to fill their Thanksgiving morning. Why trot with the turkeys, when you can come to Marshfield and **GOBBLE WOBBLE?**

The 14th annual race will start and finish at the Webster County Health Unit, 233 E. Washington in Marshfield, rain or shine. Start time for the 5k fun event is 8:00 am. This year's event promises to be more enjoyable for young and old alike with a fresh new look and newly designed shirts for the first 150 people to register. Registration fees are a modest \$20 for adults and \$10 for youth participants. First, Second, and Third place finishers will be handsomely rewarded.

100% of all funds raised from the event (sponsors and participants) will help to support the Marshfield Action Sports Syndicate (MASS), a non-profit volunteer program working hard to provide Webster County youth with positive recreational activities. Volunteers from MASS will be on site Thanksgiving morning to answer questions about their program.


