

Subject: Respiratory Viruses Take A Toll On Webster County

Marshfield, MO – As cold and flu season continues, Webster County health officials are urging the public to take preventive measures to protect themselves and others from respiratory viruses, including the flu, COVID-19, and RSV. One of the most effective ways to reduce the spread of these viruses is by staying home when you're sick and getting vaccinated.

Stay Home if You're Sick

The simplest and most effective way to prevent spreading respiratory viruses is to stay home when you're feeling unwell. Whether you're dealing with mild symptoms like a sore throat or a runny nose, or more severe symptoms such as fever or fatigue, staying home helps prevent the virus from spreading to coworkers, classmates, and loved ones.

"Even if you think you have a mild cold, it's important to avoid public spaces and protect others, especially those who are vulnerable, such as the elderly, young children, and individuals with compromised immune systems," said Ladi Moore, Nurse Epidemiologist for the Webster County Health Unit. "Rest, hydrate, and recover at home so that you can return to your routine when you're feeling better, without risking the health of others."

Get Vaccinated

Vaccination remains one of the most effective ways to prevent severe illness from respiratory viruses. Vaccines are available for many respiratory viruses, including influenza and COVID-19, and can help reduce the severity of symptoms if you do get sick.

"Vaccination not only protects you but also helps protect your community by reducing the spread of harmful viruses," Moore continued. "Getting vaccinated is a simple but powerful step to protect yourself, your family, and others who may be more at risk of serious complications."

Most recommended youth and adult vaccines are available at the Health Unit for little or no cost, and no appointment is necessary.
