



In a proactive effort to support suicide prevention, the Webster County Health Unit in partnership with the **Webster County Community Partnership**, is launching a new initiative to provide Home Safety Kits aimed at reducing access to lethal means. The kits contain essential tools to promote safe medication storage, proper disposal, and firearm safety. The Home Safety Kit includes a medication lock box, a firearm lock, a medication disposal item, and printed materials with suicide prevention resources. By offering these free kits, the Webster County Health Unit aims to create safer home environments and prevent tragic outcomes by addressing common risk factors.

“Suicide prevention starts at home,” said Ashley Dedmon, Health Educator and Project Director. “By securely storing medications and firearms, individuals and families can take a simple but impactful step toward reducing the risk of suicide.”

The program is designed for individuals and families who want to take proactive measures to ensure the safety of their loved ones. The kits are available by completing an online survey at <https://tinyurl.com/websterpreventionprogram>. Once the survey is completed, the kits can be picked up at the Webster County Health Unit in Marshfield. Program participants may enter into a drawing for a chance to win a home gun safe valued at \$1,000.00.

The Health Unit encourages community members to take advantage of this resource and to spread awareness about the importance of lethal means safety. Those in crisis or concerned about a loved one are urged to call 9-8-8 for immediate support.

**SBA Offers Relief to Missouri Small Businesses and
Private Nonprofits Affected by November Drought**
Low interest disaster loans now available

SACRAMENTO, Calif. – The **U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA)** announced the availability of low interest federal disaster loans to small businesses and private nonprofit (PNP) organizations in Missouri who sustained economic losses caused by the drought beginning Nov. 1, 2024.

The disaster declaration covers the counties of Barry, Bates, Benton, Boone, Callaway, Camden, Cass, Cedar, Christian, Cole, Cooper, Dade, Dallas, Douglas, Gasconade, Greene, Henry, Hickory, Jasper, Johnson, Laclede, Lawrence, Maries, Miller, Moniteau, Morgan, Newton, Osage, Pettis, Phelps, Polk, Pulaski, St. Clair, Stone, Vernon, Webster and Wright in Missouri, as well as Linn and Miami counties in Kansas.

Under this declaration, SBA's Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) program is available to small businesses, small agricultural cooperatives, nurseries, and PNPs with financial losses directly related to the disaster. The SBA is unable to provide disaster loans to agricultural producers, farmers, or ranchers, except for small aquaculture enterprises. EIDLs are available for working capital needs caused by the disaster and are available even if the small business or PNP did not suffer any physical damage. The loans may be used to pay fixed debts, payroll, accounts payable and other bills not paid due to the disaster.

"Through a declaration by the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture, SBA provides critical financial assistance to help communities recover," said Chris Stallings, associate administrator of the Office of Disaster Recovery and Resilience at the SBA. "We're pleased to offer loans to small businesses and private nonprofits impacted by these disasters."

The loan amount can be up to \$2 million with interest rates as low as 4% for small businesses and 3.625% for PNPs, with terms up to 30 years. Interest does not accrue, and payments are not due, until 12 months after the date of the first loan disbursement. The SBA sets loan amounts and terms based on each applicant's financial condition.

Applicants may also call SBA's Customer Service Center at (800) 659-2955 or email **disastercustomerservice@sba.gov** for more information on SBA disaster assistance. For people who are deaf, hard of hearing, or have a speech disability, please dial 7-1-1 to access telecommunications relay services.

Submit completed loan applications to SBA no later than **Nov. 25**.
