

Webster County will begin accepting applications for a new senior citizens' tax credit program on Tuesday, April 15th through June 30th. To be eligible, taxpayers need to be at least 62 years old (prior to January 1, 2025).

The tax credit applies to residential real estate taxes on the eligible taxpayer's primary residence. The intent of the credit is to limit future increases in residential real estate taxes – described generally as a 'freeze' – to 2025 (or 'base year') levels.

There are some exceptions, including: a) tax levies guaranteed by the state constitution (the state blind fund; and any general obligation bonds); and b) voter-approved tax levy increases adopted after 2025 (or base year).

Applications can be submitted in-person at the County Clerk's office (Courthouse, 101 S. Crittenden St., Rm. 12, Marshfield). Applicants should bring: 1) driver's license or other I.D.; 2) voter registration card or other proof of residency (such as a utility bill); and 3) their paid 2024 real estate tax receipt.

It is important to clarify that the program is not a tax exemption, but merely a 'freeze'. Eligible taxpayers whose applications are approved will receive a 'normal' tax bill in 2025 that will become the basis for 2026 and future real estate taxes. Therefore, the impact of the program will be modest in the short term, but grow in value over a period of time. It is also important to state that the program does not apply to personal property taxes paid on vehicles, etc.

The State law authorizing the tax credit is relatively new, and many of the details are still being worked out. It is anticipated that eligible taxpayers will need to apply each year. Everyone's patience as we work through this new process is appreciated.

The application is available on the county's website:

www.webstercountymo.gov. Beginning on April 15th, applications will be accepted at the County Clerk's Office in the historic courthouse located at 101 S. Crittenden St., Rm. 12, Marshfield, MO 65706. For more information, feel free to contact the County Clerk's office at 417-859-VOTE (8683).

Marshfield is experiencing a strong seller's market as we continue to hover around 2 months of inventory. The most noticeable change we saw was the median number of days homes were on the market before going under contract. It took about 2 months for homes to go under contract in 2024, but in March that amount of time dropped to only 23

days! Homes are typically selling close to their asking price and at a healthy price point.

Overall, these metrics suggest that now may be a favorable time for sellers to list their homes, as demand is high and properties are selling quickly at competitive prices. Buyers should be prepared to act fast and potentially make strong offers in order to secure a property in this competitive market.

The average rate on a 30-year mortgage dropped slightly in March, with 2 rate cuts anticipated for 2025. This slight dip in mortgage rates can create more buying power and we will see many more buyers re-enter the market because of it.

March 2025 Median Estimated Property Value


