empower: abilities proudly serves as the Center for Independent Living in Southwest Missouri, supporting people with disabilities to live independently—with dignity and choice. One of our most impactful services is Consumer Directed Services (CDS), a program that allows individuals to stay in their homes by choosing their own caregiver.

If any of the following sound like your situation, empower: abilities may be a great fit for you:

- You're helping someone in their home with daily tasks.
- Someone is already helping you at home with your daily tasks.
- You need help in your home to stay safe and independent.
- You're receiving care now but aren't happy with your current provider.

Through CDS, individuals who need assistance with tasks like bathing, cooking, dressing, laundry, errands, housekeeping, and toileting can hire someone of their choice—often a friend, family member, or loved one—to be their Personal Care Attendant.

This program not only promotes independence but also supports our local workforce. Personal Care Attendants are paid weekly, making this a meaningful job opportunity for those already providing care or looking to make a difference.

We are always seeking caring, dependable people to support consumers who need help finding a caregiver.
