Applicants must be 62 or older before 1/1/2025 to file for a tax credit on their primary residence.

Items Needed:

- Completed Application - available at webstercountymo.gov or at the Courthouse
- Proof of Identity/Age - Drivers License, Passport, etc.
- Proof of Residency - Voters Registration or Utility Bill
- Proof of Current Taxes - Real Estate Tax Receipt.
