On Sunday, April 18th, 1880 the town of Marshfield Missouri was nearly blown off the map. In less than a minute the town was almost totally destroyed and 99 people were killed, with 200 more being injured, some left with lifelong disabilities.

On Saturday. April 18th the Webster County Historical Society will host a **free** presentation showcasing what might have been a conversation of friends a year after they survived the Cyclone and the devastation of the event that happen almost 150 years ago. Although there are, of course, no survivors still living we do have a book, *Rachael weeping for her children*, that was written by survivors. We also have pictures and newspaper articles written in the days that followed the storm, which by todays standards was an F4 tornado. The presentation will present the information from these sources. There will be pictures and items that survived the cyclone to see, as well as some newspaper articles written in the days that followed. There will be a time for questions as well as sharing facts about a baby or babies in treetops and other interesting and factual stories. The public is invited to attend this free event and learn more about what really happened that frightful evening. The program will start at **5:30 at the Jackson Event Center at the corner of West Jackson and South Clay Streets in Marshfield.**

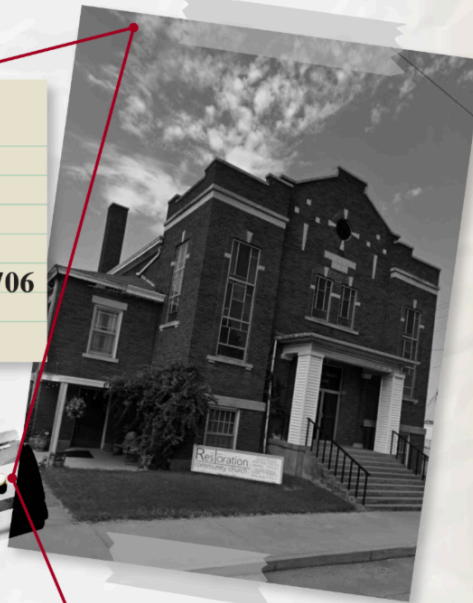
