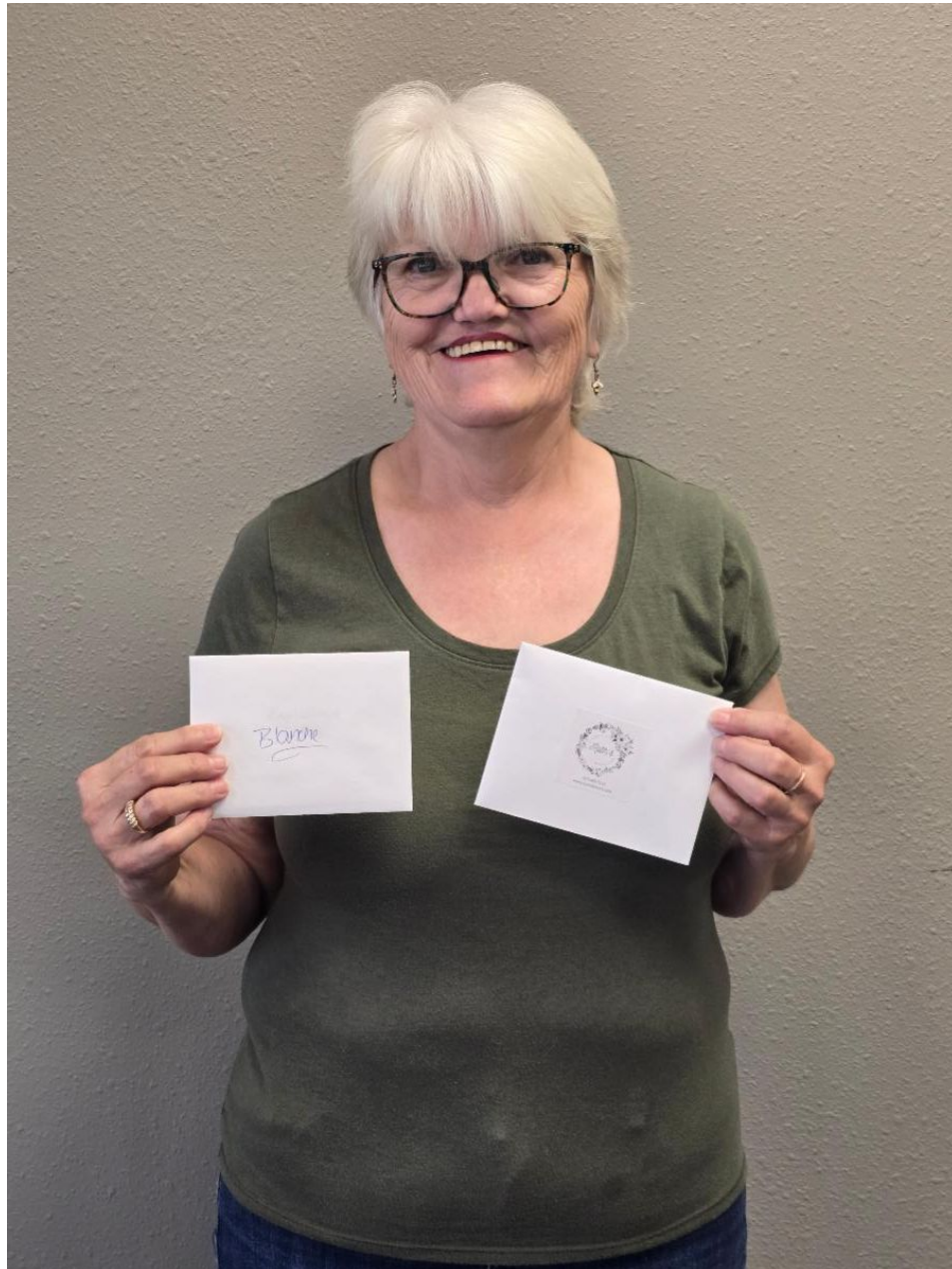
This week, we are honored to recognize Tina Clancy!
