Here is what Shannon shared:

"I would like to nominate Marc Baker, Dianna Schuman, and Megan Dinwiddie from the Marshfield Parks and Recreation Department for Thankful Thursday. Every summer, they interview and hire around 75 people to help run Marshfield's programs. Most of those hires are teenagers between 15–18 years old, and for many of them, it's their first job.

They spend a lot of time training these kids in customer service, umpiring, and lifeguarding, while also making sure they have the certifications they need to do the job. They are patient with schedules, activities, and all the things that come with working with teenagers, but they still expect them to show up ready to work and do their jobs well.

As a mom of two lifeguards, I really appreciate everything they do for the teens in this town. They are teaching them responsibility, work ethic, and how to be good employees. Their time and effort make a big difference for a lot of young people in our community."
