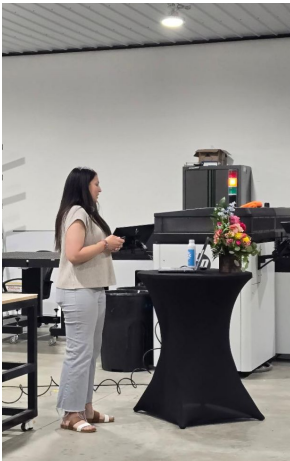
On Monday, we celebrated Paige Turning Moments with a ribbon cutting as they officially joined the Marshfield Chamber — and it also marked their grand opening!

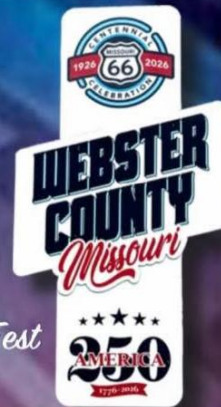
