DISASTER ASSISTANCE FOR BUSINESSES AND PRIVATE NONPROFITS

SBA Disaster Loan Deadline Approaching for Missouri Businesses and Private Nonprofits

The U.S. Small Business Administration is reminding eligible small businesses and private nonprofit organizations impacted by the drought beginning Sept. 9, 2025, to apply for low-interest federal economic injury disaster loans before the deadline.

Eligible Counties

Missouri: Barry, Barton, Bollinger, Butler, Camden, Carter, Cedar, Christian, Dade, Dallas, Dent, Douglas, Greene, Hickory, Howell, Iron, Laclede, Lawrence, Madison, McDonald, Newton, Oregon, Ozark, Polk, Reynolds, Ripley, St. Clair, Shannon, Stoddard, Stone, Taney, Texas, Vernon, Wayne, Webster, and Wright

Arkansas: Baxter, Benton, Boone, Carroll, Clay, Fulton, Marion, Randolph, and Sharp

Who Can Apply

- Small businesses
- Private nonprofits & faith-based organizations
- Small agricultural cooperatives & nurseries
- Small aquaculture enterprises

Loan Assistance Available

➤ Economic Injury Disaster Loans: Working capital assistance for operational expenses caused by the disaster.

Key Loan Details

- Up to \$2 million in loan funding
- Interest rates as low as 4% for small businesses and 3.625% for private nonprofit organizations
- Loan terms of up to 30 years
- No interest or required payments during the first 12 months following disbursement

Application Deadline: Economic Injury Disaster Loans: Aug. 31, 2026

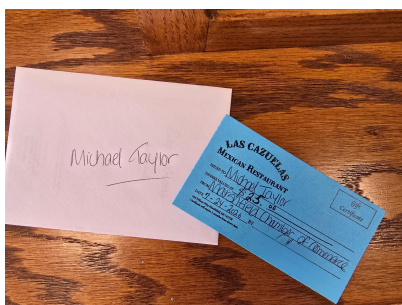
